

Draft MINUTES of the 5th HENRE Annual Meeting 6th of March 2014 Austria Center Vienna

1. Welcome and introductions

Sija Geers-van Gemeren, vice president of the EFRS, welcomed all delegates, and followed by a short introduction round of all participants.

2. Minutes of the 4th HENRE annual meeting (2013)

There were no questions or remarks and the minutes were approved unanimously.

3. HENRE management team

3.1 Report HENRE MT activities 2013 Louise Rainford presented an overview (app. 2). Most activities will be followed up in 2014. One of the main activities is the creation of an interactive research platform for radiography. Data are being collected and offers with details and cost to build a web based structure are requested. Form 1 was already distributed. From a total of 81 EFRS member organisations 59 have replied, which represents a **73%** response rate. Form 2 (to the identified researchers) will follow soon. It was agreed to send the research forms 1 and 2 back to the responders for a last check before publishing the data these on line.

3.2 Proposal for the organisation and election of the MT

Sija Geers gave a short explanation about on why and how this proposal was prepared with the HENRE MT. There were no further questions and the proposal was approved unanimously.

4. HENRE finances. Result 2013, budget 2014 and proposal 2015.

A typing error, already noticed in 2013, will now be corrected. The budget for travel 2014 and 2015 will therefore be €3.100,00, instead of €3.000,00. The question was raised why the amount for EFRS overhead was raised. The answer was that this is to cover (part of) the increased amount of work done by the EFRS CEO specifically for HENRE (finances, member registration/contacts, organisation of the AM etc.). The HENRE budget 2015 will be on the agenda of the EFRS AGM 2014 for final approval as integral (and unchangeable) part of the EFRS budget proposal 2015.

5. Clinical Competences – draft questionnaire

The draft questionnaire was discussed in two subgroups. The outcomes of the group discussion will lead to a new draft, which will be circulated to the HENRE members for a last check in April. The questionnaire will be part of the EFRS education survey 2014 to be run in September.

Main recommendations for the new draft: add clear definitions of terms like tutor, clinical supervisor; distinction between practice in Skills lab or with patients in the clinical environment; clarification of study load in hours as well as ECTS and inclusion of only clinical supervisory staff/student ratios; the final level of learning at qualification for Radiography Programmes. It is decided not to include the list with competences in the survey.

6. HENRE activity plan 2014.

The HENRE activity plan is now combined with the EFRS activity plan to express the coherence in actions.

7. Student affairs & student meeting feedback.

At the end of the day the students presented the outcomes of their student meeting to the HENRE audience. (Appendix 3) The students were thanked for their active contribution to the student programme and for leading their session.

8. Closing of the annual meeting.

The question was asked to whether EFRS plans to draft an EQF benchmark document for EQF level 7. The answer was that this would be a useful activity, but that it first should be decided how detailed this would have to be. KSC at Master level are already included in the EQF and Bologna descriptions and are at a higher level of abstraction than for radiographers qualifying at level 6. Master degrees in radiography can be modality focused or much broader. Also post graduate knowledge to work safely and adequate with specific modalities not necessarily has to be at Master level. It is decided that the small group that drafted the level 6 document will get in contact for a brainstorm.

All participants were thanked for their active contribution to the discussion.

After lunch the meeting was followed by a HENRE seminar on "Curriculum requirements for Evidence Based Practice".
